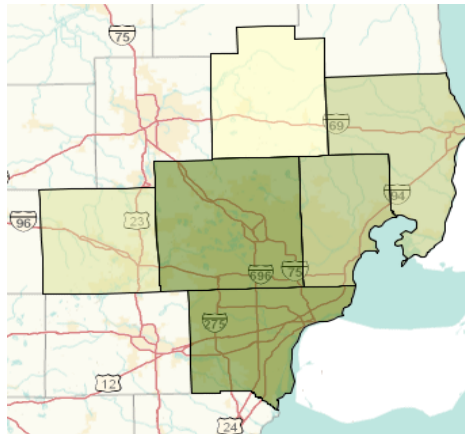


Economic Census: Local Business Snapshot

DID YOU KNOW?

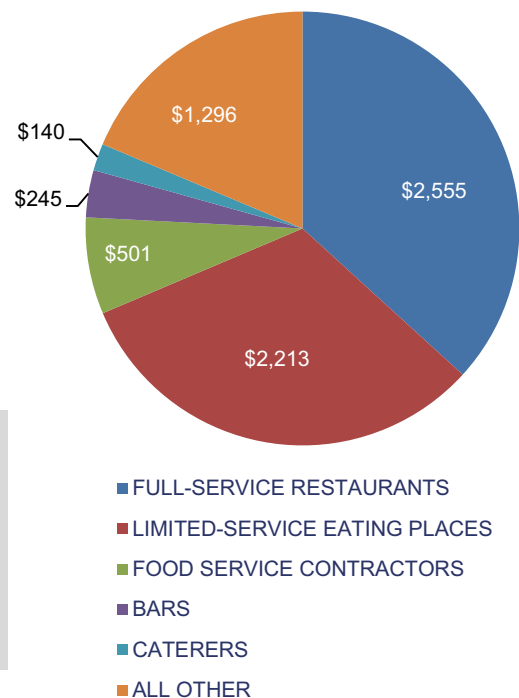

The Detroit metro was ranked 11th among U.S. metros in the number of businesses in the Health Care and Social Assistance sector (12,227 establishments).



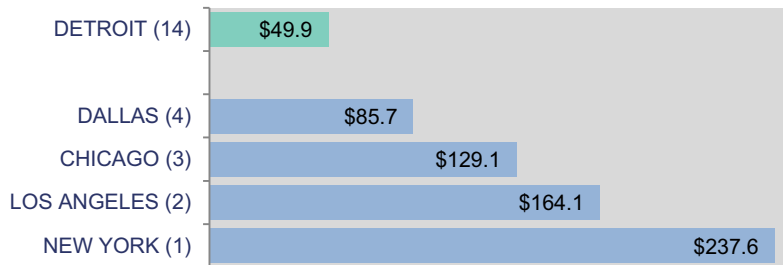
HEALTH CARE AND SOCIAL ASSISTANCE BUSINESSES IN DETROIT METRO COUNTIES: 2007
